EFIS is delighted to announce four extraordinary new awards to recognize Europe's young talents in the fields of immunology and allergology:

#### **ACTERIA Doctoral Thesis Prizes**

and

### **ACTERIA Early Career Research Prizes**

Thanks to a recently established partnership with the **Fondation ACTERIA** - **ACT**ing on **E**uropean **R**esearch in **I**mmunology and **A**llergology - EFIS will award these prizes for the best doctoral theses defended in the last 3 years prior to the award nomination deadline and for the best early career research work of investigators with up to 10 years postdoctoral experience. In all, four (4) Prizes will be awarded:

- 1 for Best Doctoral Thesis in Immunology;
- 1 for Best Doctoral Thesis in Allergology;
- 1 for Best Early Career Research in Immunology;
- 1 for Best Early Career Research in Allergology.

Candidates eligible for each of the ACTERIA Doctoral Thesis Prizes must have earned their PhD (or equivalent) after March 1st, 2010, i.e., three (3) years prior to the application deadline (see below); similarly, candidates

eligible for each of the ACTERIA Early Career Research Prizes must have earned their PhD (or equivalent) after March 1st, 2003, i.e., ten (10) years prior to the deadline.

These prizes carry cash awards of €15,000 and €30,000 each, respectively. In addition, awardees will automatically become eligible for 3-year research grants of up to €50,000 annually.

# Nominations will be accepted <u>exclusively</u> from EFIS-affiliated National Societies.

The ACTERIA Prizes awarded by EFIS will be made for the first time at the 2013 International Congress of Immunology (ICI) in Milan at a special awards ceremonyon August 25th, 2013, during which each of the four prize winners will be expected to speak and present his or her work. Thereafter, the awards will be presented at the tri annual European Congress of Immunology (ECI) organized by EFIS, starting in 2015 in Vienna.

EFIS-affiliated Societies are hereby invited to solicit and accept individual applications for each of the prizes from qualified eligible candidates (who are expected to be members in good-standing of the nominating Society) until <u>March 8th, 2013</u>.

Societies will evaluate and select the candidates they wish to nominate for each prize - according to internal procedures deemed appropriate - then submit their four nominations to EFIS - <a href="mailto:secretariat@efis.org">secretariat@efis.org</a> - by no later than March 15th, 2013.
